



## EAGLE CITY FC: PROFILE

Eagle City FC was established in 2019 in the Mihango area in Utawala as a community football club dedicated to transforming grassroots football. Our training pitch (Tai grounds) is situated at Mihango Chief's camp next to AIC Church. Affiliated with the Federation of Kenyan Football, it began as a volunteer initiative to develop young talent and is currently participating in the FKF Sub-County League with strong community and parental support. Sponsorship from Utawalla Sacco and occasional support from Hon. Kigwathi (Kados), who facilitated a public training venue, have been vital to its success. The club has produced players who now compete in the Kenyan Premier League and internationally, including in the USA.

The club has the following club structure:

- **FKF Sub-County League:** Eagle City FC competes in the FKF Nairobi East Sub-County tier, representing the community at the grassroots competitive level.
- **Junior Academy:** Eagle City FC operates a comprehensive junior academy for kids and teenagers, providing structured training and development programs for young players.
- **Seniors Team:** Our seniors' team competes every Saturday at Ballmania Turf Utawala Benedictor.

The club's social impact is significant, providing a positive environment that discourages drug abuse, teen pregnancies, violence, and gang involvement. Beyond sport, Eagle City FC promotes values of teamwork, discipline, responsibility, patriotism, and community well-being. The club urgently appeals for corporate and individual support to sustain its mission and youth development.
